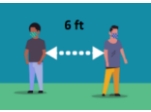
As the situation is continually changing, check back often. All attendees are responsible to know and follow the rules listed. **COVID-19 WAIVER must be completed by all attendees.**

### Do Not Proceed If:

- You have signs and symptoms of a fever or high temperatures (100.4°F/38°C or higher).
- You have signs and symptoms of coughing, shortness of breath, or respiratory problems.
- You have had contact or exposure with any potential source of the virus.
- Within 14 days of beginning of show, if you have been exposed to a positive tested person, please stay home.

### Club Protocols:

It is important here at these events to ensure precautions are maintained for everyone's health and safety. Below are the new guidelines and practices moving forward until further notice in response to COVID-19. These trials will not be operating as "business as usual" and requires the following changes. **We will be adhering to CDC and AKC guidelines. It is imperative that all attendees strive to be as safe as possible.**

**General Practices:** Clubs, officials, and participants are required to follow guidelines that apply to the area/site where the event is held. Exhibitor should follow the above safety steps as frequently as possible. Avoid physical contact (i.e., shaking hands, hugging), touching dogs that are not your responsibility, and sharing common use items (i.e., pens, pencils). Although the club has worked diligently to provide some sanitizing supplies around showgrounds, please also be self-sufficiently prepared with personal hand sanitizer, personal face masks, and memorize armband number before going to ringside. Do not congregate at the ring or either ring gates.

**Face Masks:** Per State of California health orders, everyone is required to appropriately wear face coverings anytime outside of one's home. **Face masks must be properly worn, covering the nose and mouth completely, or you cannot participate in the show. Exception:** Exhibitors may remove their mask while under their own tent. The mask must be put on correctly, covering the nose completely and mouth completely when exhibitor is outside of personal tent area.

**Crating/Shade:** Do not remain on show grounds longer than necessary. For others entering in multiple classes and/or setting up canopy, please do not share canopy with anyone that is not from your immediate household. If you are asked to move farther away, Please Do It.

**Check-In:** Maintain at least six feet distance between stewards, secretary, and/or possible line of people.

**Grooming Restrictions:** Grooming areas should comply with social distancing guidelines, at least 6 ft apart. Forced air dryers and fans of any sort are not allowed ringside.

**Prizes:** At the conclusion of each class, judge will identify placements.

- a. Maintain social distance.
- b. Steward will sanitize hands before sorting ribbons and place on table.
- c. Exhibitor will pick up ribbon when exiting the ring.

**Spectators:** Please help to minimize the number of people on showgrounds. Spectators (i.e., significant others, spouses, non-participating individuals) are not recommended.

**Judges and Stewards:** Social distance shall be maintained as much as possible in and around the ring amongst each other. Hand sanitizing options will be provided ringside for easy access and those who wish to add additional layer of protection.

**Photography:** Judge may not be featured in win photos or special posing will be required.

**Any person who fails or refuses to follow these established guidelines during the event or anywhere on showgrounds will be investigated by trial committee for misconduct prejudicial of the sport.**

Any change or cancellation must be made in writing and received prior to closing, except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show Rules and Regulations.

When entering online, you will receive email acknowledgement of entries immediately. Once payment is received and entry is confirmed, you will receive an ENTRY CONFIRMATION email, no later than end of closing day. Mail-in entry acknowledgment will be made as soon as possible or after entries have closed. Should such acknowledgments not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, check your junk email box and/or email [Entries@DogZibit.com](mailto:Entries@DogZibit.com) or call 425-765-9146. Judging Programs emailed at least a week prior to show.

**RAMP** -- A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/ show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp). Special notice to judges and exhibitors — Basset Hounds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition. This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds.

**DO NOT LEAVE DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.** If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the Event Committee for disciplinary action. All persons attending these events hereby waive any claim for damages against the host clubs, its members, Show Secretary, or the property owner in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

**CLEAN UP IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY.** Violators may be reported to the Event Committee for disciplinary action. Have someone supervising your setup area at all times at the event site.

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

*VETERAN DOG, 6 years & older	*VETERAN BITCH, 6 years & older

The winners of these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed. Any veterans defeated in these classes may not compete for Best of Breed, even if entered in the class.

\*Chapter 11, Sect 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "Neutered dogs and spayed bitches would be allowed to compete in Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed."

\*\*The Field Trial Dog and Bitch Classes are open to any Basset Hound which has placed in an AKC member or licensed Field Trial. Judging will be on conformation only and by virtue of winning the class may compete for Best of Breed. A photocopy of the ribbon earned must accompany the entry in the Field Trials classes. A neutered dog or a spayed bitch cannot be entered in the Field Trial classes.

### BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered in this competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs, which according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

### JUDGES AWARD OF MERIT

The Greater San Diego Basset Hound Club offers 1 Award of Merit for every 7 competing in the Best of Breed competition, up to the maximum of five (5) Awards of Merit, to be presented in addition to but not including Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. There will be a special Rosette for each Award of Merit recipient. The judge may at his or her discretion award all or none of the rosettes. Receiving an "Award of Merit" is indeed a significant honor.

### BEST BRED-BY EXHIBITOR (Saturday only)

RULES: The same rules that apply to eligibility to compete in the regular Bred-By-Exhibitor classes apply to eligibility to compete in Best Bred-By-Exhibitor in Breed. During the course of regular breed judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor from the class winners of the Bred-By-Exhibitor classes. This will be done after Best of Breed judging unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic: Example: An entry from the Bred-By-Exhibitor classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only the dog and bitch undefeated in it's Bred-By-Exhibitor class are eligible for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Competition. If the first-place winner is not present the second place winner may not compete.

### PARADE OF TITLEHOLDERS (Saturday only)

For all Basset Hounds achieving any AKC or Basset Hound Club of America recognized title. The fee is \$18.00. A large, beautiful rosette with the dog's name in top-quality gold-leaf on 16" streams will be presented.

## **NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**

\*STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dogs and a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 4 of their Get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. The stud dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog class. Additionally, Get appearing with a Stud Dog must also be entered individually at this Specialty. Neutered dogs may be shown in this class.

\*BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as Stud Dog Class, substitute “Brood Bitches” for “Stud Dogs,” “Produce” for “Get” and “Spayed” for “Neutered.”

BRACE – For two (2) Basset Hound dogs or bitches that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. Brace Fee is \$20.00 for the Unit when entered in addition to a regular or non-regular conformation or obedience class (excluding sweepstakes). If not entered in regular or non-regular conformation class (excluding sweepstakes), fee is \$30.00 per dog.

NOTE: As the judge’s decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

\*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the “Rules Applying to Dog Shows” provides that “a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.”

## **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP – PM SHOWS ONLY**

**NOVICE CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

### **NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:**

- **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show
- **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show
- **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

**BEST JUNIOR HANDLER:** Winners from each class will compete for Best Junior Handler.

**NOTICE:** Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

**NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S):** There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

## SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION – AM SHOWS ONLY

**Eligibility:** This Sweepstakes is open to all Basset Hounds, who, on the day of the show, will be at least six months and under eighteen months of age. Classes to be divided by sex and age. Sweepstake Classes will be judged prior to the regular breed classes. Professional and/or Paid Handlers may only show dogs they own in Sweepstakes. No Champions may be shown in Sweepstakes. **Dogs shown in Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in one of the regular classes.** Indicate "Sweepstake & Age Division" in the Additional Classes space.

### SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

Puppy Dogs, 6 mos. & under 9 mos.	Puppy Bitches, 6 mos. & under 9 mos.
Puppy Dogs, 9 mos. & under 12 mos.	Puppy Bitches, 9 mos. & under 12 mos.

The class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes & Best Opposite in Sweepstakes.

### VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION

**Eligibility:** This Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Basset Hounds, who, on the day of the show, will be at least 6 yrs of age. Neutered males and spayed bitches are eligible for Veteran Sweepstakes. Judging will be held prior to regular classes. Professional and/or Paid Handlers may only show dogs they own in Veteran Sweepstakes. A dog **DOES NOT** have to be entered in the Regular Classes at this show. Indicate "Sweepstake & Age Division" in the Additional Classes space.

### VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

Veteran Dogs, 6 yrs and under 9 years	Veteran Bitches, 6 yrs and under 9 years

### SWEEPSTAKES AND VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES MONEY PRIZES

All entry money in each class will be divided as follows (rounded to the nearest dollar amount). *Any undistributed funds revert to the Club.* 30% of total Sweepstakes fees will be retained by the club to defray expenses. The remaining 70% balance will be distributed as follows:

- Best in Sweepstakes – 8%
- Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes – 4%

Thereafter the remainder of the stake for each class will be divided in the following manner (for classes with fewer than four entries, prizes will be distributed proportionately.)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Place – 40% of remaining fees in class
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Place – 30% of remaining fees in class
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Place – 20% of remaining fees in class

**CHALLENGE TROPHIES**

**ALL CHALLENGE TROPHIES** – A \$100.00 deposit per trophy is required of any winner wishing to take possession until the next Specialty, except for very special circumstances, to be determined by the Trophy Chairman and the Club's Board. Trophy must be returned to the Trophy Chairman in satisfactory condition prior to official start of the next Specialty Show. Any damage will be deducted from deposit and balance if any, returned to depositor. Engraving charges will be reimbursed upon presentation of bill to Club Treasurer. No trophies will be mailed.

The following trophies are offered by various donors through the Greater San Diego Basset Hound Club for competition at it's Specialty Shows only. For permanent possession these trophies must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog or bitch nor at consecutive shows.

**BEST OF BREED** – The Splash Challenge Trophy, in honor of GCHG Splash's The Professor R.O.M. and Ch. Me-Don's Ol' South's Top Priority R.O.M., a Silver Plated Bowl on a Walnut Base, offered by Bill, Jo Ann, Jackie, & Will Nolan.

**BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX TO BEST OF BREED** – The Splash Challenge Trophy, in honor of Ch. Splash's Tsunami of Woodhaven "Moosie", a Decorative Pewter Loving Cup on a Wooden Base, offered by Bill, Jo Ann, & Jacqueline Nolan.

After which time no entries can be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Any change or cancellation must be made in writing and received prior to closing, except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show Rules and Regulations. Fees must accompany entries; DogZibit assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. The Club and/or DogZibit assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner.
2. No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, FAX email, phone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted.
